I have been working as a TA for 13 years now. I worked in 5th

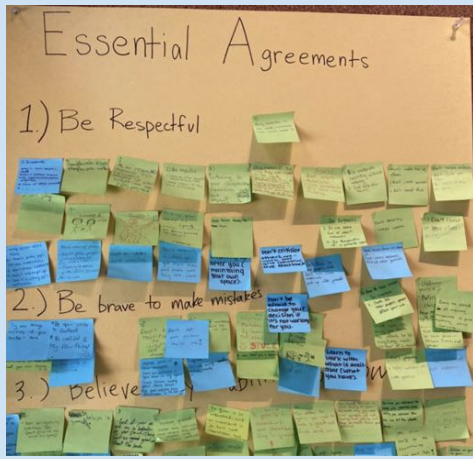
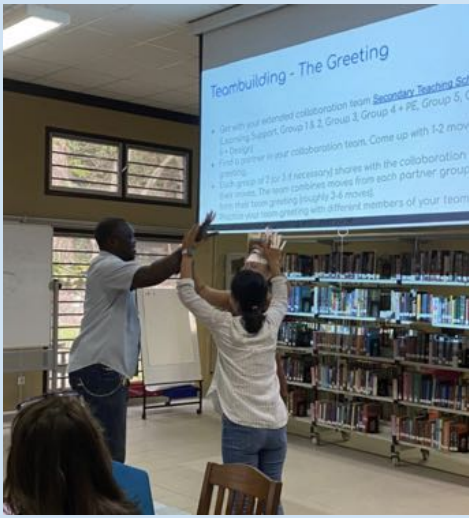

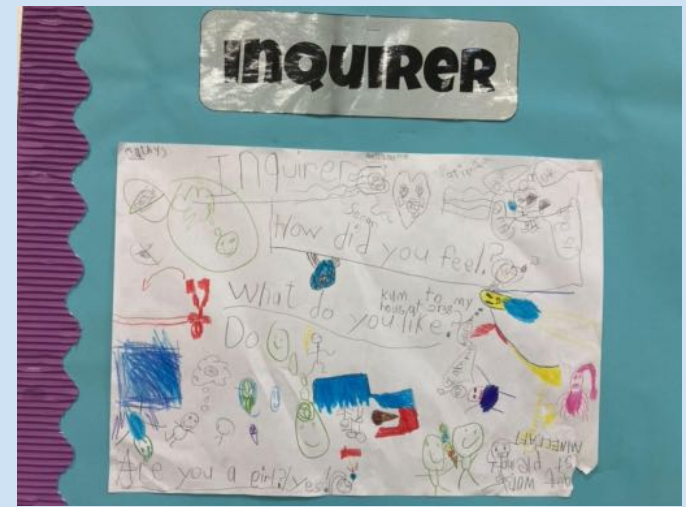
We are back! From day one of the 2022-2023 school year, students jumped right into engaging with each other, developing essential agreements, getting to know their teachers and new friends.

## EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

This year, we are very excited to be offering a full range of extracurricular activities, as we will offer three distinct extracurricular programs: After School Activities, Play Productions and Athletics.

TASOK believes that participation in extracurricular activities is an integral component of holistic student development. Participation in extracurriculars allows TASOK students the freedom to go beyond the classroom, to discover new and unique activities that interest them, and offers faculty and staff the opportunity to impart skills and expertise to our students in a variety of activities.

#### **AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES (K - Gr. 12):**

After School Activities are offered at TASOK on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays after school from 3:20 – 4:30 PM. TASOK community members volunteer their time, and TASOK teachers are contracted to sponsor one club, activity, and/or varsity sport each year in hopes that all students will find something that interests them. Most activities are free, however on occasion an organization will run an ASA and may charge a fee to students.



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ASAs are usually divided into grade levels in order to best suit student abilities and needs (ie: K-1, 2-3, 4-5, 6-8, 9-10, 11-12).

### **ATHLETICS (Gr. 6-12):**

The Athletics program is designed to provide an authentic sports experience for every athlete. Students will be able to join a team which will be well-equipped, well coached, and that challenges students to improve their skills in appropriate ways. TASOK believes that offering a wide range of competitive sports adds value to the educational experience of the participants. Emphasis is placed on participation, sportsmanship, and development of skills. Coaches are both role-models and teachers for athletes, fostering positive attitudes, teamwork, and respect for rules. Student-athletes have the opportunity to compete in both local and international tournaments and competitions.

Practices take place after school from 3:20 - 5:30 and on Saturday mornings. Teams will have at least two weekday practices and one Saturday practice in which all student-athletes must participate.

Thank you families for contributing to a great start of the 2022-2023 school year! We thank all who already returned their tuition agreements and paid the school fees according to the selected plans: A, B or C.

We urge those who have not yet completed their payments to do so as soon as possible. Penalties will start to apply this month. Payment methods are listed below for your convenience.

### Payment Options

TASOK offers families and companies the convenience of making tuition payments online. To provide this method of payment, we partner with Diamond Mind/Community Brands, an independent school payment service provider. All payment information is completely secure using the highest security standards in the industry.

#### WEBSITE OPTION

Go to the school website's "Payment Portal" link, or enter it directly clicking here: [PAYMENT PORTAL](#)

- Sign-up to set up an online account;
- Enter student first name, last name and ID with payment information; the student ID # is on the invoice;
- Submit payment. Payment acceptance methods and any fees associated with an electronic payment are outlined in the payment portal.

#### MOBILE OPTION

You can also pay using our mobile payment app: MySchoolWallet©

*Signing into the MySchoolWallet App for the first time?*

- Go to the App Store on your phone.
- Search for MySchoolWallet and install.
- Complete your profile and select The American School of Kinshasa as your school and hit PAY.
- You will see various events and departments, listed as payment types. Select one of the payment types and follow the onscreen directions. Be sure to complete the student's name and fill out the NOTE with what the payment is for (for example, Tuition or Student Store, Event, etc...)
- Please check the box "I would like to absorb processing costs so that the school receives my whole payment." Each transaction incurs a processing cost from the bank.
- Once your transaction has gone through, you will receive an email confirmation and receipt.





Note that payments can be made via credit card (worldwide), debit card or echeck (for US accounts only). For online payments, receipts are automatically generated after each transaction. Note TASOK systems do not accept payments for the canteen orders. All must use the EKONZOFOOD platform to replenish their account and order lunch. See the details posted in this TASOK TALK edition and on our website.

### BANKING OPTION

- Direct deposits (cash or check) at bank counters into TASOK's account are accepted.
- Wire or ACH transfers are accepted.
- Online banking from your bank DRC or US bank to ours is possible. Check with your institution for options available to you.
- Most US transfer options work: wire, ACH, e-check, BillPay, Zelle, etc... These options are only available for US transactions, not international.
- Once the transaction is complete, send the confirmation to us.

### ON CAMPUS OPTION

- TASOK Cashier Office accepts cash up to 1,000 USD.
- TASOK Cashier Office accepts debit and credit cards for payments via POS. Both ATM & POS accept VISA® & Mastercard®.
- TASOK Cashier Office accepts paper checks issued to The American School of Kinshasa. Checks from a local DRC or US bank are accepted.

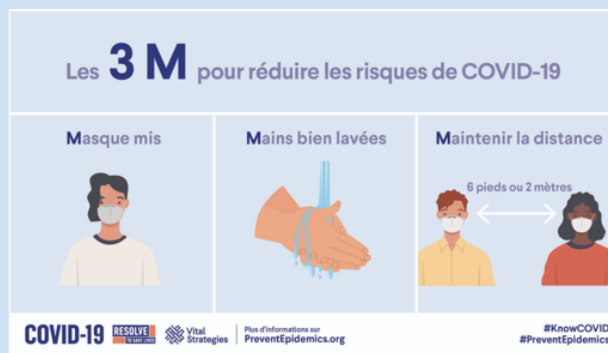
